2018 School Boundary Advisory Committee Recommendations

Charges

The SBAC shall examine potential attendance zones as well as related challenges associated with new and anticipated growth of CCISD and recommend new attendance zones which:

- Maximize the learning opportunities and needs for student achievement;
- Make efficient use of instructional facilities;
- Consider available data provided by the district and demographer; and
- Consider constructive public feedback.



Guidelines

Stability: Minimize disruption of the community.

- Minimize movement of existing and future student population.
- Retain traditional neighborhood, municipal and geographic boundaries when practicable.
- Maintain existing instructional programs at current facilities.

Foresight: Make recommendations utilizing demographic forecast.

- Consider demographics and all reasonable, available information.
- Minimize potential for future reversals.



Guidelines

Efficiency: Make efficient use of resources.

- Avoid under or over utilizing facilities when possible.
- Consider cost of recommendations on facilities.
- Consider net impact of recommendations on bus routes.

Service: Meet community needs.

- Consider the demographic balance.
- Maintain effective feeder patterns and consider correcting irregular feeder patterns.

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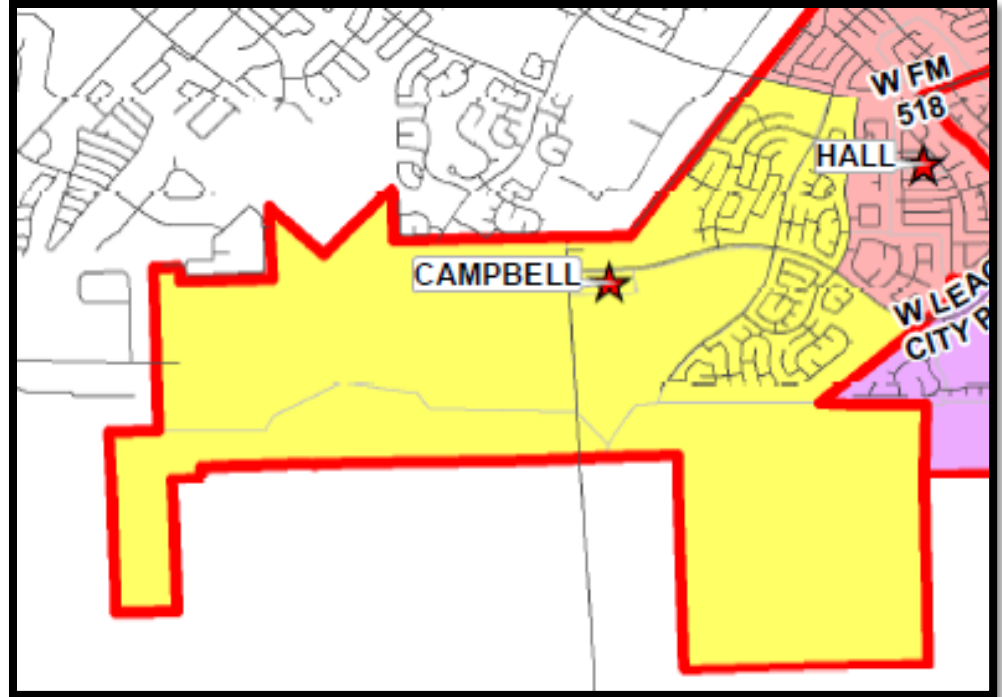


Elementary SBAC Recommendations



Hall Elementary to Campbell Elementary (new)

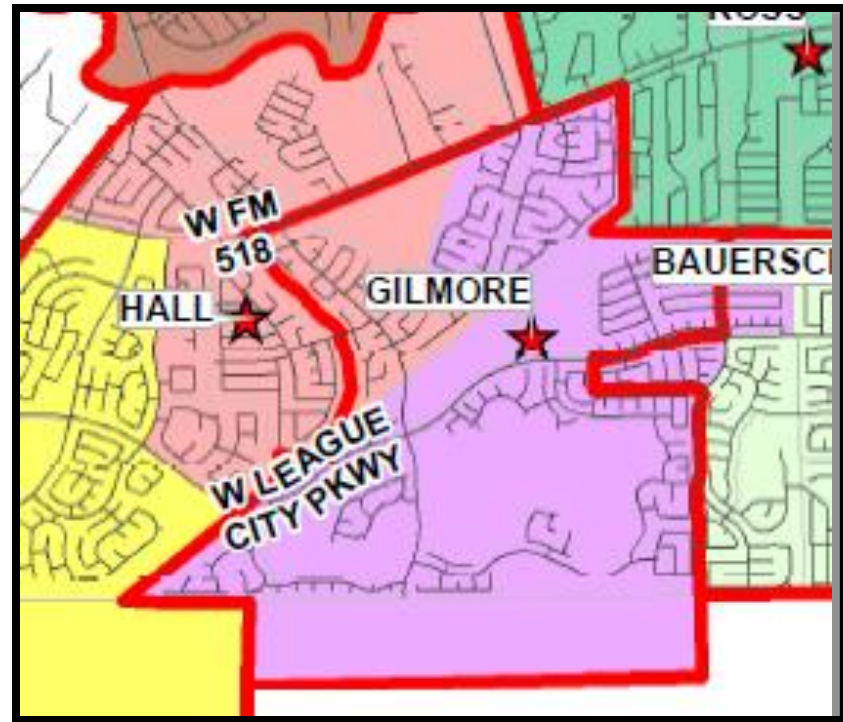
With the opening of the new Florence Campbell Elementary in August 2019, we recommend developing the Campbell Elementary attendance zone.



Gilmore Elementary to Hall Elementary

We recommend
moving 123 students
from Gilmore to Hall.

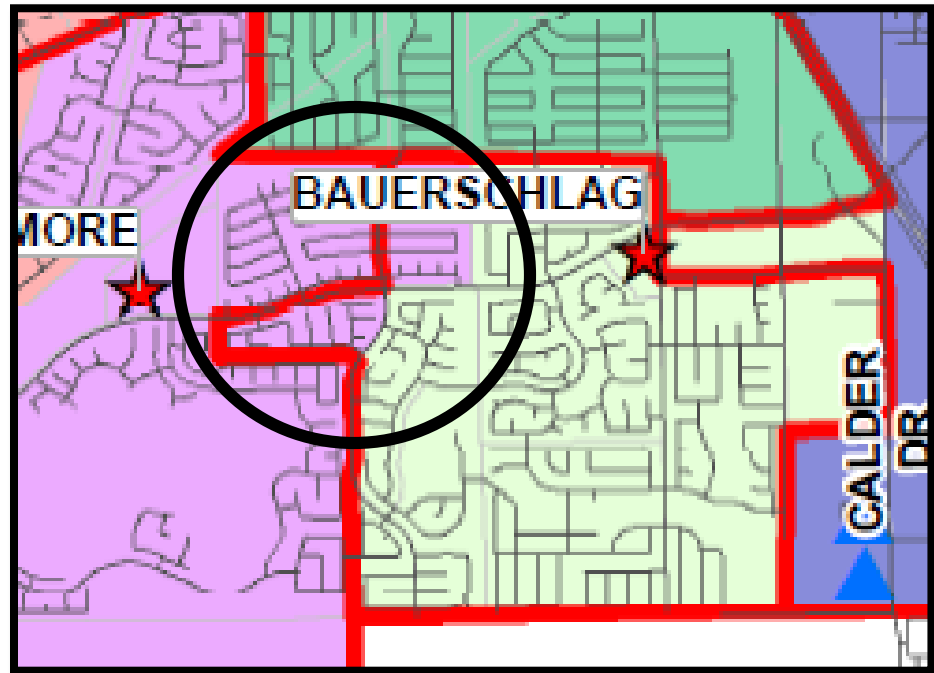
Under this
recommendation
Rustic Oaks along Bay
Area Blvd will shift
west to Hall
Elementary.



Bauerschlag Elementary to Gilmore Elementary

We recommend moving
123 students from
Bauerschlag to Gilmore..

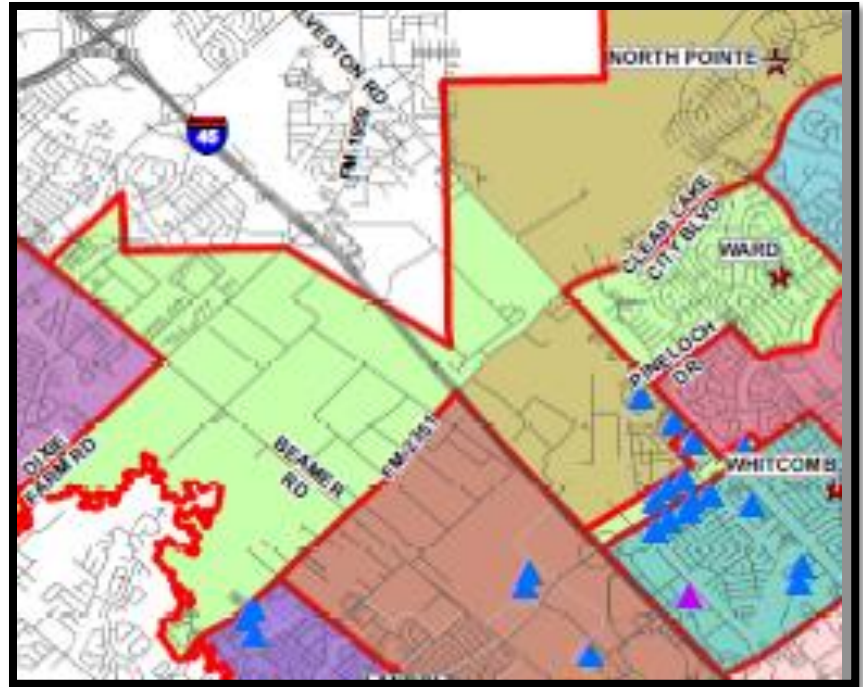
Under this
recommendation The
Landing subdivision will be
zoned to Gilmore and not
split between the two
schools as in the past. A
small portion of Brittany
Lakes south of League City
Parkway west of Landing
Boulevard will come to
Gilmore.



North Pointe Elementary to Ward Elementary

We recommend moving 185 students from North Pointe to Ward Elementary.

All areas to the west of IH 45 currently zoned to North Pointe will be moved to Ward under this recommendation to better use the capacity of this school. Ward is also closer to IH 45 than North Pointe



Brookwood Elementary to Robinson Elementary

We recommend
moving 30 students
from Brookwood to
Robinson

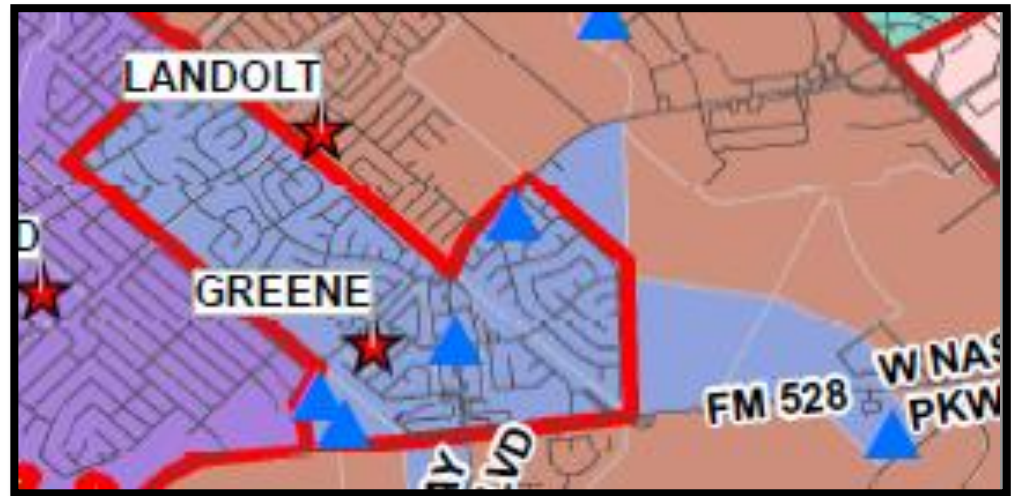
This boundary

Landolt Elementary to Greene Elementary

We recommend moving 64 students from Landolt to Greene.

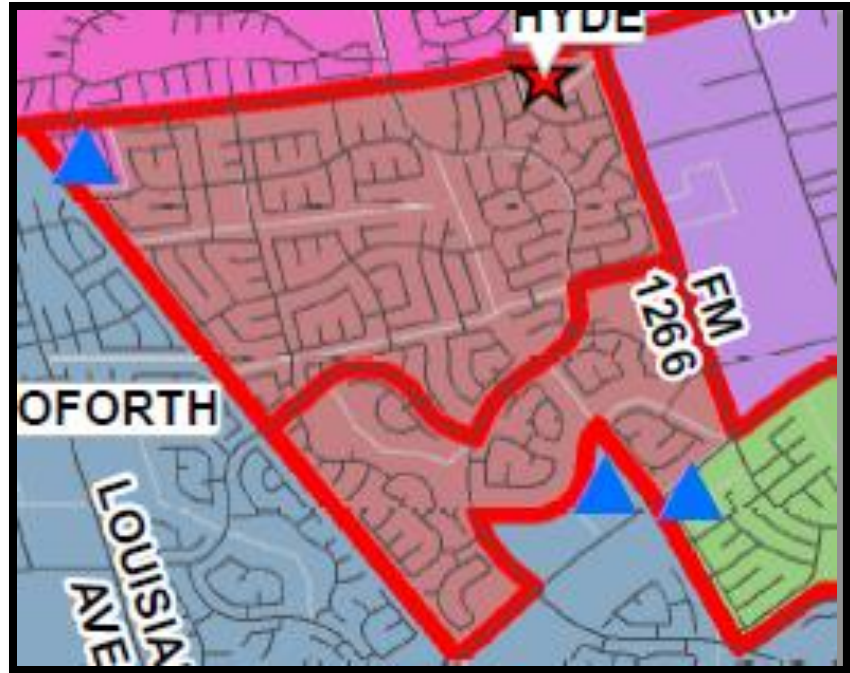
This minor boundary change includes removing two apartment complexes along FM 528 and moving these into Greene Elementary.



Mossman Elementary to Hyde Elementary

We recommend moving 237 students from Mossman to Hyde.

This recommendation will move all the Lakes of South Shore from Mossman into Hyde Elementary School.

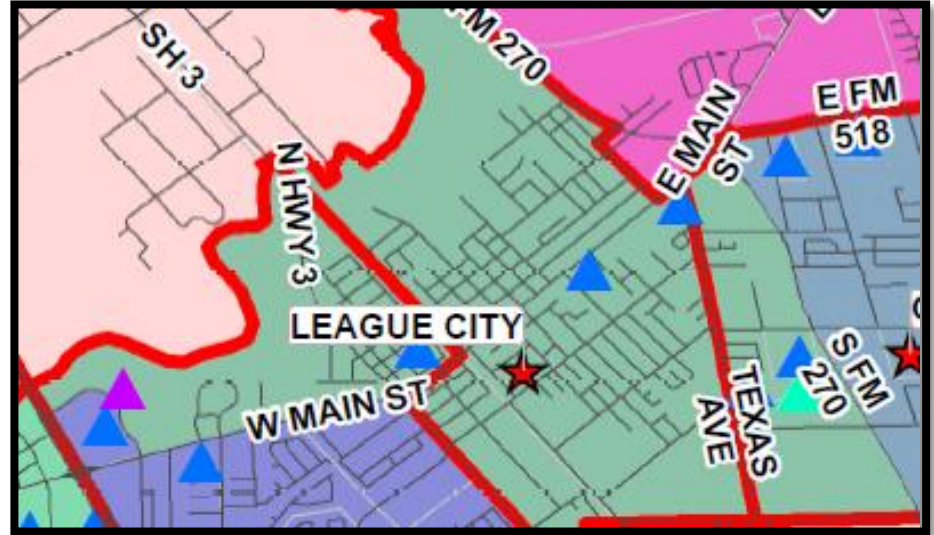


Goforth Elementary and Parr Elementary to League City Elementary

For the 2020-21 school year, we recommend moving 51 students from Goforth to League City.

For the 2020-21 school year, we recommend moving 61 students from Parr to LCE.

SBAC recommends extending the LCE attendance zone from Texas Avenue to FM 270 and from SH 3 to IH 45 north of W. Main Street.



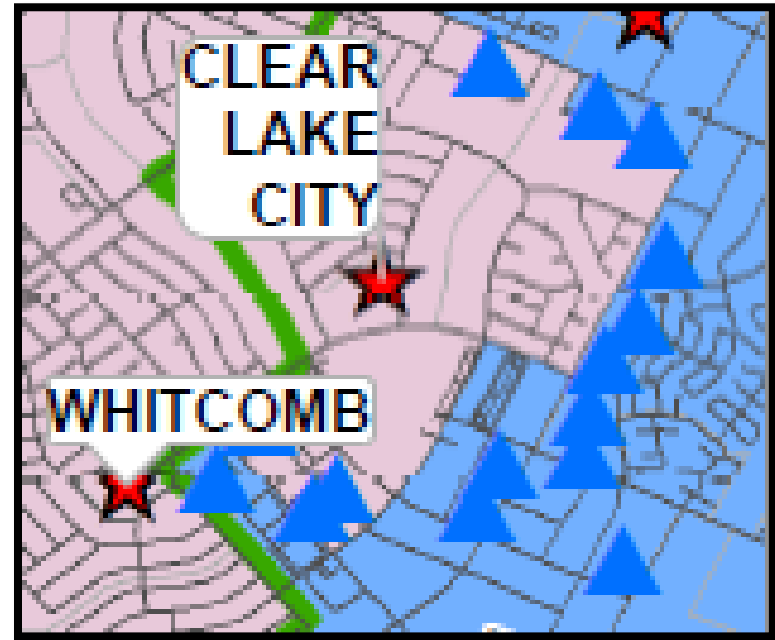
Secondary SBAC Recommendations



Space Center Intermediate to Clear Lake Intermediate

We recommend moving
205 students from Space
Center Intermediate to
Clear Lake Intermediate.

This recommended change
will result in all Clear Lake
City Elementary School
attending Clear Lake
Intermediate, rather than
the current split between
two schools.



Seabrook Intermediate to Space Center Intermediate

We recommend moving
148 students from
Seabrook Intermediate
to Space Center
Intermediate.

This recommended
change will result in all
Robinson Elementary
School attending Space
Center Intermediate,
rather than the current
split between two
schools.



League City and Bayside to Clear Creek Intermediate

We recommend moving 215 students from League City Intermediate and 157 students from Bayside Intermediate to Clear Creek Intermediate.

This recommended change will result in all Hyde Elementary School attending Clear Creek Intermediate, rather than the current split between two schools.

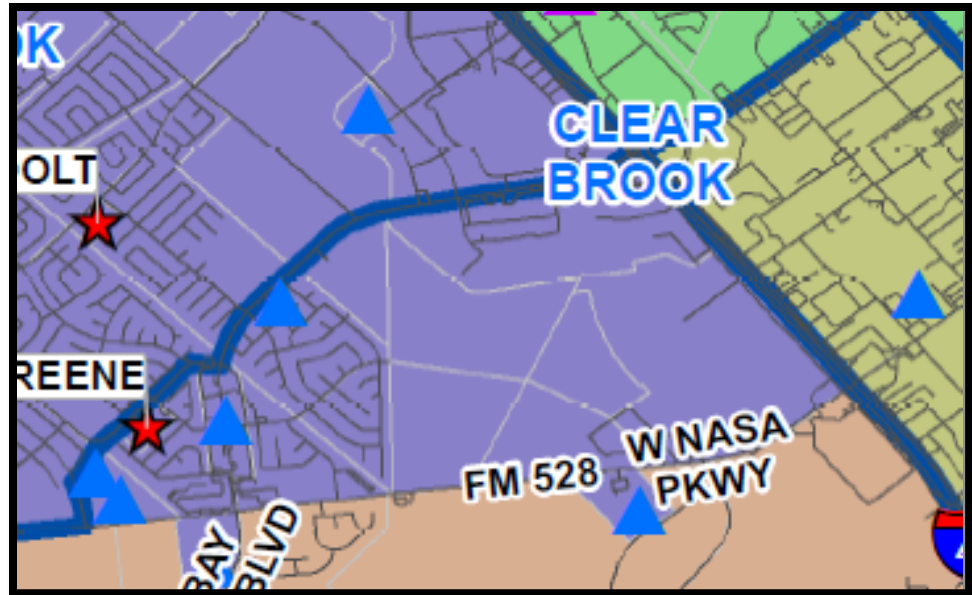


Clear Springs High School to Clear Brook High School

We recommend moving 243 students from Clear Springs High School to Clear Brook High School.

The recommended change extends the Brook boundary to FM 528, as well as bringing in Emerson Park Apartment Homes and Reserve at Autumn Creek Apartments.

These proposed changes result in a feeder patterns of Greene Elementary to Brookside Intermediate to Clear Brook High School.

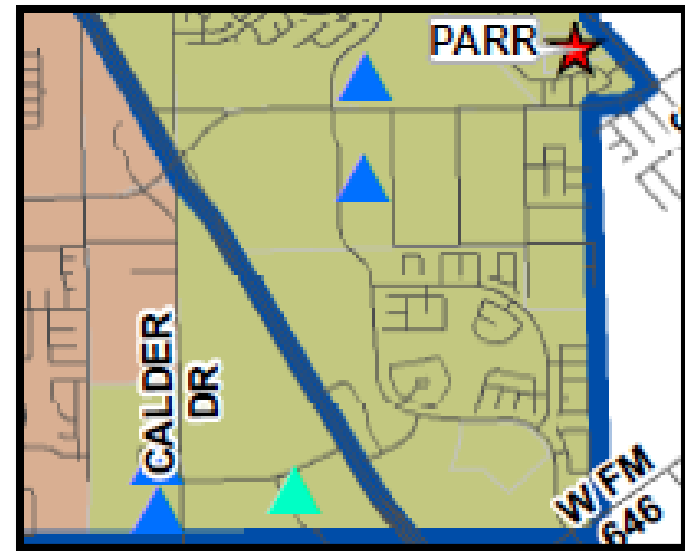


Clear Springs High School to Clear Creek High School

We recommend moving 39 students from Clear Springs High School to Clear Creek High School.

This recommended change extends the Creek boundary slightly west of IH 45 near Calder Road.

This recommendation results in the uninterrupted feeder pattern of Parr Elementary to Victory Lakes to Clear Creek High School.



Clear Falls High School to Clear Lake High School

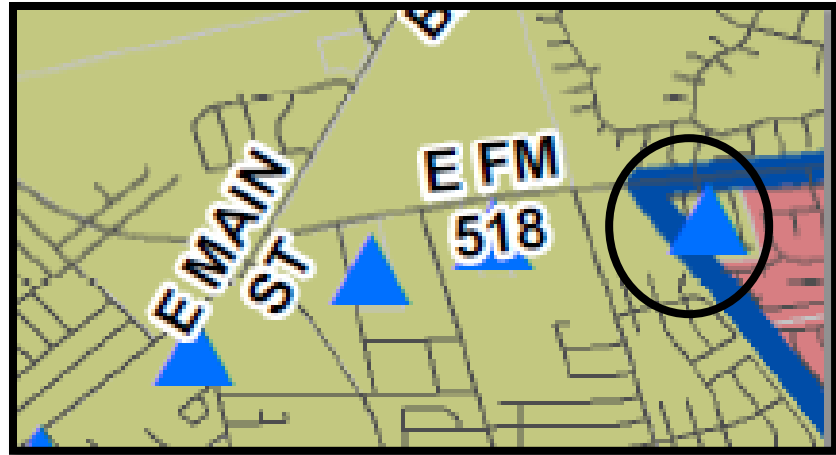
We recommend moving 236 students from Clear Falls High School to Clear Lake High School.

This recommended change brings the subdivisions along Kirby Road into Clear Lake High School.



Clear Falls High School to Clear Creek High School

We recommend moving 37 students from Clear Falls High School to Clear Creek High School.



This recommended change brings the Coronado Apartments back to Clear Creek High School.
