Did you know...

- In 2006, the State Legislature approved House Bill 1. This legislation reduced school district maintenance and operation (M&O) property taxes by one third over a two year period (2006-07 & 2007-08). As a result, Clear Creek ISD's local M&O tax rate was reduced from \$1.50 to \$1.00 per \$100 valuation in effort to give homeowners property tax relief.
- The State expanded the business franchise tax and added several new state taxes to help fund this reduction in local school district revenue.
- Clear Creek ISD does not receive the tax revenue generated from property value growth. Additional tax revenue generated from local value increases since 2006 have accrued to the State and not Clear Creek ISD. The school funding system prior to the 2006 Legislative session allowed school districts to hold onto that revenue from local property growth for one year.
- The funding school districts receive from the state is based on 2006 revenue per student. The funding system does not provide additional funding to districts to cover inflation due to rising costs of fuel, electricity, property and casualty insurance, and teacher pay raises. CCISD receives roughly \$5,365 per student.
