



CLEAR BROOK HIGH SCHOOL PARKING RULES

1. Each vehicle or motorcycle parked on the campus must have a current parking sticker registered with the security office. Students are not allowed to share parking permits or purchase a permit on behalf of another person.
2. To be valid, the CBHS parking permit must be permanently affixed to the front passenger side of the windshield in the lower corner. A permit not easily visible will subject the vehicle to ticketing/towing/booting at owner's expense. Permits attached with tape, attached to vinyl, plexiglass, etc., are invalid and will subject the vehicle to ticketing/towing/booting at owner's expense and/or loss of permit.
3. Parking stickers are not transferable from one vehicle to another. If the student changes vehicles, the permit must be peeled off (even in pieces) and returned to the office to register the new vehicle with a new permit number.
4. For a permit, students must present a valid Texas drivers license, permanent Texas license plate number (no temporary license plates allowed), a current student ID, and show proof of liability insurance, including the student name printed on the insurance card listed as an insured driver for the vehicle. The permit cost is \$35. Replacement cost is \$2.
5. Temporary permits are granted ONLY to students already holding a valid permit. To obtain a temporary permit, you must know your permit #; color, make, model, and license plate number of the temporary vehicle. Temporary permits should be obtained the day prior to use. A parent letter of explanation is required in advance with any request that exceeds three days.
6. Students must park in designated student parking lots and marked parking spaces. Vehicles parked in visitor spaces, teacher lots, driveways, posted no parking areas, or in unmarked areas are in violation and subject to ticketing/towing/booting, and/or loss of permit.
7. Maximum speed is 10 mph or less, depending upon existing driving conditions. Hot rodding, spinning tires, and other reckless driving are violations and subject to school discipline, ticketing, towing, and/or permit forfeiture.
8. During the fall semester, any vehicle left in lot #1 (marching band practice area) after 3 PM will be towed at owner's expense. The coaches' lot is always restricted to faculty permits (24 hours/7 days).
9. Students are not permitted to loiter in the parking lots at any time. Other than scheduled arrival and departure times, NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT without written permission from the SLC principal, INCLUDING LUNCHES. Consequences include, but are not limited to, penalties for being off limits and possible forfeiture of parking privileges.
10. Violations of the above listed rules, as well as the Student Code of Conduct, may result in ticketing, towing, permit forfeiture, and/or school discipline. Upon the receipt of a third ticket, a third towing, or unpaid tickets, or any combination of these, the permit will be forfeited. No refund will be given for any forfeited permit.
11. Towing fees, tickets and boot fines must be paid within 10 school days.
12. Students who leave school in a vehicle without permission, and/or drive other students off campus without permission, will forfeit their permits and be subject to school discipline.

EXCESSIVE DISCIPLINE CAN RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF PARK PRIVILEGES.
