GKDA (REGULATION)

Free Student Materials

Free materials (books, pamphlets, charts, maps, calendars, films, slides, exhibits) may be accepted for use in the schools provided they meet the following standards:

- The materials shall contribute positively and effectively to the promotion of the educational program approved by the District.
- The name of the donating firm may appear, but not with such emphasis or repetition as to subordinate the educational content.
- The materials shall be evaluated in accordance with Policy EFA(LOCAL), for instructional content, and policy FMA(LO-CAL), for non-instructional content.
- 4. The principal purpose of the literature shall not be promotion or sales.

Student Flyers

- 1. Non-profit organizations and for-profit businesses must submit a Flyer Distribution Approval/Denial Form and non-profit documentation, if appropriate, online.
- Clear Creek ISD school-related flyers (dance clinics, sports camps, carnivals, festivals, booster club activities) must be submitted online.
- 3. All approved flyers will be distributed to families by way of an online website with printable flyers.
- 4. One paper flyer distribution date per school year will be established for school-related and non-profit summer camp information only.
- 5. Flyers will be denied for the following reasons:
 - a. In accordance with FMA (LOCAL)
 - b. In accordance with GKB (LOCAL)
