## **Course Options**

The following guidelines are to be used in student placement in the District Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP):

Intermediate Students Intermediate students assigned to Clear Path Alternative School are given the opportunity to continue study in core courses in math, English, science, and social studies. Core courses are taught on level only. Students enrolled in elective courses will have those courses serviced through work assigned from their home campus teacher while enrolled in Clear Path Alternative School. The home campus teacher will be responsible for packaging assignments, projects, exams, etc., for a student assigned to CPAS and send it to CPAS. Staff at CPAS will monitor the elective work, projects, exams, etc., and return the work product to the home campus for their evaluation and assignment of grade.

High School Students High school students assigned to Clear Path Alternative School will be given the opportunity to continue study in core courses in math, English, science, and social studies.

Students that are enrolled in Honors or AP courses will receive instruction on-level while assigned to Clear Path Alternative School. The home campus teacher will provide all Honors and/or AP mandatory assignments and assessments but will not provide any supplemental support including but not limited to tutorials. CPAS will provide support but will not provide instruction at the honors or AP level. A discussion with administration will be held regarding this information and an opportunity to level down will be provided.

Students enrolled in elective courses will have those courses serviced through work assigned from their home campus teacher while enrolled in Clear Path Alternative School. The home campus teacher will be responsible for packaging assignments, projects, exams, etc., for a student assigned to CPAS and send it to CPAS. Staff at CPAS will monitor the work, projects, exams, etc., and return the work product to the home campus for their evaluation and assignment of grade.
